1. Kenya.

3. Sierra Leone

Sierra Leone is rebuilding after a civil war. Literacy, they believe, is crucial. Half of the adult women can not read or write and yearn for teachers to teach them.

4. Cameroon

"Girl child education". Teach girls who have been left out of education.

5. Sri Lanka

Help establish school and pre-school programs across this island paradise.

The poor can not afford school so gain literacy skills through this organization.

7. Nepal

Teach English & academics to the indigent in one of the world's most spectacular settings.

8. Honduras

Teach kids who have been abused, orphaned by poverty.

9. Bolivia

Bolivia is poor and children are at high-risk. Do you speak Spanish?
